- 5. Congressman Ruben Gallego for U.S. Senate (D) in Arizona First Hispanic Male U.S. Senator from Arizona
- Congresswoman Emilia Sykes (D) for re-election in Ohio 13th Congressional District –
  Retains a Democratic swing seat, First African American woman elected to this Congressional
  District in Ohio History
- 7. Congresswoman Sharice Davids (D) for re-election in Kansas 3<sup>rd</sup> Congressional District Retains a Democratic swing seat, First Native American woman elected to this District in Kansas History
- 8. Congressman Gabe Vasquez (D) for re-election in New Mexico's 2<sup>nd</sup> Congressional District Retains a Democratic swing seat, Retains a Hispanic Democratic member of Congress.
- 9. **Michigan State Senator Kristen McDonald Rivet for Michigan's 8**<sup>th</sup> **Congressional District** First women to represent this Congressional District and retains a Democratic swing seat.
- 10. Congresswoman Marie Gluesenkamp Perez (D) for re-election to Washington State 3rd Congressional District Retains a Democratic Swing seat, 1st Hispanic American Woman elected to congress from Washington State \_
- 11. State Representative Cleo Fields (D) for Louisiana 6th Congressional District New Congressional District, Majority African American seat, increases African American representation from Louisiana to two members of Congress.



12. State Representative Shomari Figures (D) for Alabama 2nd Congressional District - New Democratic leaning Congressional Seat, increases African American Congressional representation in Alabama to two and is the first African American Democratic male elected to Congress from Alabama.
